

# **MYERS-BRIGGS PERSONALITY SURVEY**

The Myers-Briggs Personality test is widely used in business and educational settings with all age groups. It consists of a survey, followed by an identification of personality types, and a listing of careers for each of the 16 personality types. The question it helps answer is: **“what careers are people with my personality type generally successful with”?**

This survey consists of 70+ “yes or no” responses to key elements of your personality. After completing the survey, your four-letter personality type according to the Carl Jung and Isabel Myers-Briggs typology will be identified. In addition, the strengths of your answers and a description of your personality type will be given. Finally, you will be referred to the “Myers-Briggs Personality Type and Related Careers” chart, which lists 25 careers compatible with your personality type.
